ONLINE APPLICATION PROCEDURES

1. Pay application fee of 30,000 Tanzanian Shillings (for Tanzanian citizens) to Research and Consultancy Account **No. 0111 0101 5604**, NBC Bank, Corporate Branch or 30 United States Dollars (for international applicants) to NBC Forex Current Account **No. 0111 0500 0670**, Corporate Branch, **Swift Code NLCB TZTX**.
2. Avail your Bank pay-in slip of the application fee (mentioned under item 1) to the Open University of Tanzania Regional Branch which is close to you, after which, you will be given give codes for opening up your postgraduate online application portal. (**For International students, avail your BANK pay-in slip to the following email address: iso@out.ac.tz** and copy to henry.tumaini@out.ac.tz)

Avail your Bank pay-in slip of the application fee (mentioned under item 1) to the Open University of Tanzania Regional Branch close to you, after which you will be provided with a receipt and application form.
