- a) Personal details. Kindly include all authors' full names, affiliations, postal addresses, telephone numbers and email addresses on the cover page.
- b) Limitations. Full articles meant for this training should not exceed 15 pages and not less than 12 pages, including footnotes/references.
- c) Key words and Abstracts. Abstracts and key words should not exceed 500 and 5 words respectively.
- d) Formatting and footnotes. Word format, double-spaced, 12 point font, Times New Roman. Use footnotes.

e) Style guidelines. All submissions should be prepared according to an APA style.
